



Service User Hoarding on Wards

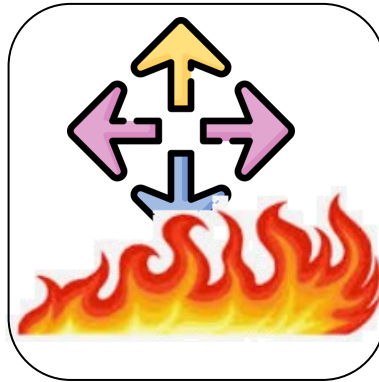
This protocol must be read in conjunction with the Trust Fire Safety Policy



Hoarding in bedrooms is a fire risk. It poses a risk to the patient, other service users and staff.



Hoarding poses a significant fire safety risk as the excessive accumulation of items in a service users bedroom



Hoarding will allow flames to spread rapidly putting the service user, other patients staff & firefighters at risk



The Clutter Image Ratings were produced after a study by The International OCD Foundation & are widely used across the world.



The Clutter Image Ratings for bedrooms are on the reverse of this protocol. Images for other rooms can be requested from the Fire Team



We should ensure that bedrooms are a rating of 3 or lower



There must be a clear path from the door to the bed



The bedroom door must fully open



As NHS staff we have a legal responsibility to keep patients and other staff safe.
